

Ride Motion Protection (RMP) 101

formerly known as RAC



Purpose:

Ride Motion Protection (RMP) is a safety program that will replace Ride Access Control (RAC) at Walt Disney Parks and Resorts U.S. sites over the next

18 months



Program Implementation:

The program implementation schedule systematically divides the parks at Disneyland® Resort and Walt Disney World® into

7 areas

Each area will experience



*Note: RAC procedures should be followed until an attraction has been converted to RMP.

What's different:

Attraction Access



A **Responsible Person** is a designated Cast Member from the Engineering Services team during non-operating hours and the Tower/Main Console Attractions Operations Cast Member during operating hours and permission must be granted from this individual for access to a Restricted Area.

RMP Procedures are always required to be followed for Restricted Area access.



Motion Accountability



Motion Accountability means that individuals must apply their own lock to a Motion Control button on the console.

Gold/Group Locks are removed from RMP.



Motion Elimination is the required mode for attraction access, unless site-specific trained or with a trained escort.



Training Requirements

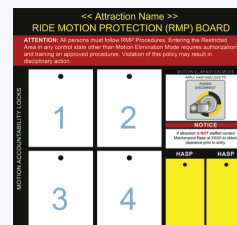
Under the new RMP program there will be multiple levels of training.
